



Flexibility of Assessment and Accreditation

NPIA offer PTRLDP learners the opportunity to achieve the nationally recognised Certificate in Teaching in the Lifelong Learning Sector (CTLLS) which includes the Preparing to Teach in the Lifelong Learning Sector (PTLLS) awardⁱⁱⁱ. This level 4 award

is aligned to the Skills for Justice Role Profiles and the Teacher Qualifications Framework designed by Lifelong Learning UK (LLUK).

Customers select the most appropriate assessment and accreditation option(s) to meet their needs and local assessment infrastructure:

- A. NPIA City and Guilds Approved Centre to achieve PTLLS and CTLLS; learning agreement established and VRQ Assessor Upskill Workshops and National Moderation events provided to support the assessment and verification process (free to Home Office Forces)
- B. Local Approved Centre to achieve locally agreed qualification; customers achieve Approved Centre status or work in partnership with a local provider to achieve their preferred qualification, e.g. NVQ, VRQ, CTP, Cert Ed, etc
- C. Local assessment to meet local requirements; local assessments are used to ensure learners meet the relevant role profile or agreed standards with no external certification.

Getting the best from PTRLDP

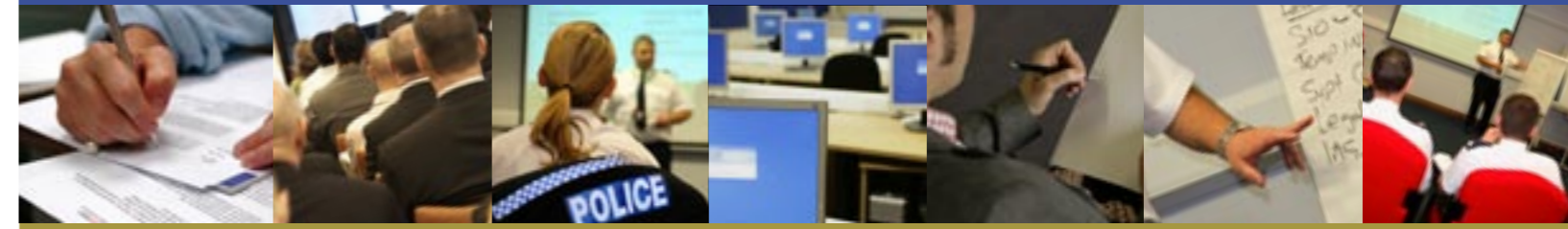
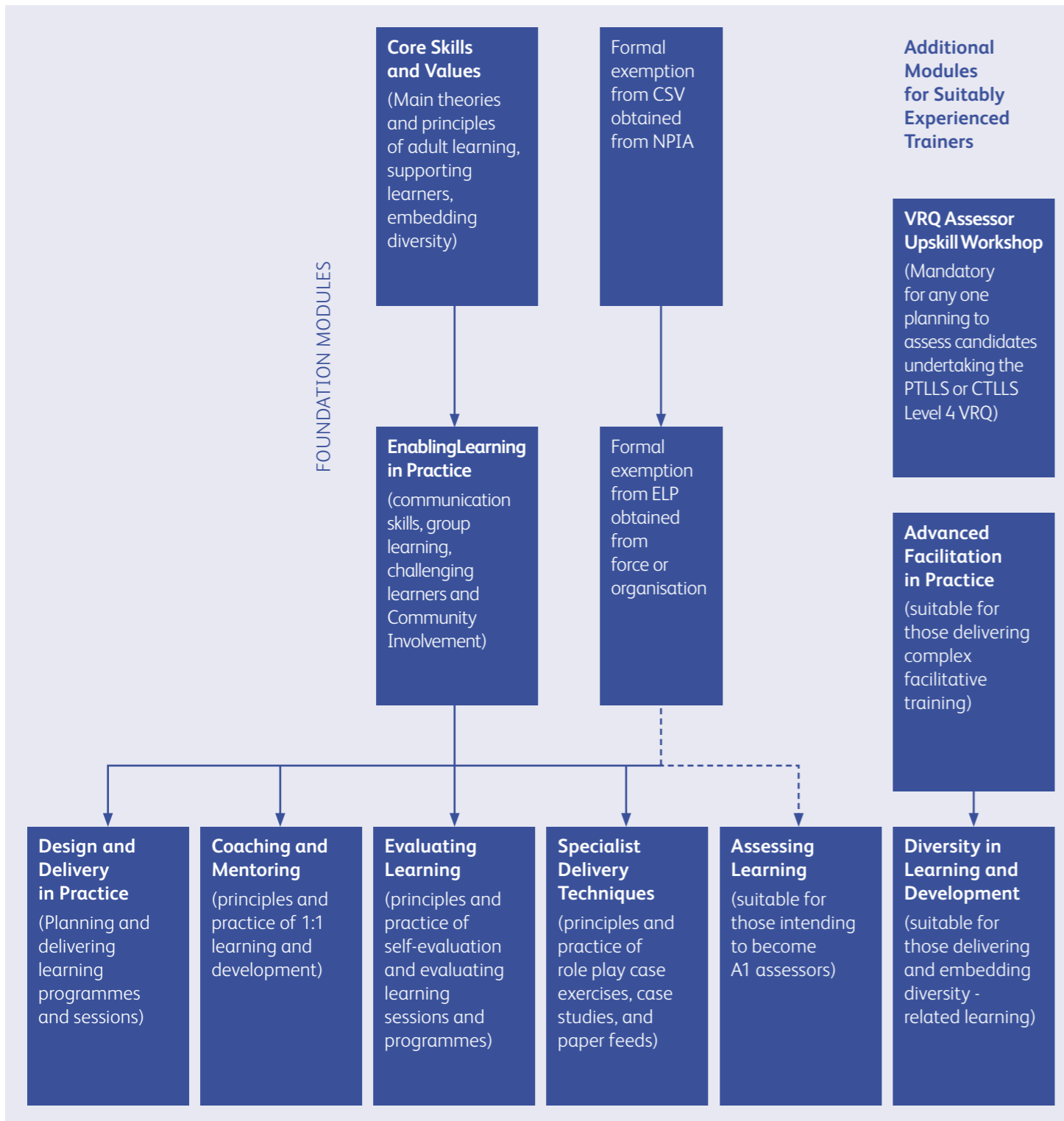
- a. Use the flexible attendance, delivery and assessment options to meet your needs
- b. Conduct an initial assessment and access the programme at the right point for your learner giving consideration to suitability for exemption
- c. Provide the necessary support and learning opportunities to meet the programme requirements, e.g. access to NCALT, appoint a work based learning mentor and support work based learning activities
- d. Agree preferred assessment option and communicate to the learner prior to their attendance on the learning programme where possible.

GETTING THE BEST OUT OF THE POLICE TRAINING ROLES LEARNING AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (PTRLDP)



Modular Structure of PTRLDP



PTRLDP is a modular programme that allows for a flexible approach to learning for all those involved in police training. Key features of the programme include:

- modular design
- blended learning, including e-learning and work based learning
- values based approach, embedding equality and diversity (AA1)
- content mapped to the Skills for Justice Role Profiles and National Occupational Standards
- flexible assessment options, leading to a nationally recognised qualification.

Flexibility of Attendance

The modular structure allows for flexible attendance and completion of the learning to meet learner needs, role requirements and progression. Our schedule of modules run at regular intervals during the year, and customers may enrol learners for individual modules, combinations of modules, or an entire programme, as appropriate to their prior experience and individual training needs. The Exemption Route enables learners who have prior teacher/training experience and/or relevant qualifications to gain exemption from the foundation modules.

Flexibility of Delivery

NPIA are committed to offering a range of flexible delivery options and has worked successfully with 11 police services over the past 2 years to enable local delivery of PTRLDP. The delivery options are:

1. Central delivery: delegates attend PTRLDP modules delivered by NPIA at one of our national NPIA sites (free to Home Office Forces)
2. Local delivery by NPIA: PTRLDP is delivered at your local premises by NPIA trainers (cost: £12,000ⁱⁱ)
3. Local co-delivery: PTRLDP is delivered at your local premises by NPIA trainers in collaboration with your force trainers (cost: £12,000ⁱⁱ)
4. Full local delivery: PTRLDP is delivered at your local premises by your own local trainers enabled and supported by NPIA (free to Home Office Forces).
